

Lake Mohawk POOL GUIDE

Rules & Regulations

Pool Membership

Provides access to the Pool facilities and amenities to include swimming pool, snack bar, recreation area, clubhouse, and all social events and activities during operating schedule.

Pool Dress Code

Please use discretion regarding appropriate swimwear. Everyone is asked to enter and leave the Pool area in appropriate cover-up attire, footwear should be worn when arriving and leaving.

Swimsuits shall be worn for swimming. Cut-down jeans, cut-off denim, running shorts, tennis shorts, overalls and similar attire is not permitted for swimming. No overalls or work clothes are permitted in the pool area.

Smoking

The Pool is a smoke free recreational area. Smoking and vaping are prohibited within all indoor and outdoor areas. There are no outdoor areas designated for smoking.

SWIMMING POOL REGULATIONS

Hours of Operation:

Opening Weekend Saturday and Sunday June 8 & 9th. The pool opens at 11am and closes at 7:00pm unless otherwise noted. Please see the Pool Operating Calendar for the complete operating schedule June 8 subject to General Manager's or Pool and Committee's discretion.

Please refer to Club Calendar for specific hours for each day. Full time schedule begins on the third week of June.

Membership

Early LMCC Member Registration Begins September 1 and requires a \$100.00 deposit

Non-Resident Registration Begins March 1 and must be paid in full at time of registration.

Nonresident fees apply for all that reside outside of the LMCC reservation for all categories of membership.

LMCC Family Membership Early Registration \$395.00 per season (non-resident \$995.00)- All resident family members registered to a LMCC reservation property in good standing, or all resident members paying tenant dues associated with a LMCC reservation property in good standing.

LMCC Couple Membership \$295.00 per season (non-resident \$795.00)- Two resident members registered to a LMCC reservation property in good standing, or two resident members paying tenant

dues associated with a LMCC reservation property in good standing. One member must be 18 years or older.

LMCC Individual Membership \$195.00 per season(non-resident \$595.00)- A resident individual over the age of 17 registered to a LMCC reservation property in good standing, or an individual resident member over the age of 17 paying tenant dues associated with a LMCC reservation property in good standing.

All memberships must be paid in full by March 1 of each operating year. Any member that joins the pool after March 1 or any payment balance received after March 1 is subject to a non- early registration fee of \$50.00.

A non-early registration fee will not apply for new LMCC members that join the community and close on their property after March 1 and wish to join the pool.

All dues are seasonal and not pro rata. Management has the discretion to offer a reduced rate each August but not before.

Membership Cards

Membership cards will be issued to all permitted members within the membership category they choose. Membership cards are not transferable and only entitle the registered person to enter the pool facility

Rules on Entrance

1. Each member must show their membership card and sign in at the entrance area, including all children accompanying the member, at the designated location upon entry to the pool complex. Transfer of membership Cards is prohibited and may result in loss of pool privileges for a period of two weeks.
2. Repeated failure to present a membership card will result in a service charge as posted at the pool office.
3. If a membership card is lost, there will be a \$10 service charge for replacement.

Guests

All members must register their guests, including children, in the log provided at the entrance to the pool. They must exhibit their pool membership card upon request. The member is directly responsible for his or her guest and the guest must leave the club if the member leaves. Conduct of guests is the direct responsibility of the member.

Fees

\$10 per guest - Monday through Fridays;

\$15 per adult guest Saturday, Sundays & Holidays;

\$10 per guest under age 18 on Saturdays, Sundays & Holidays;

Children 4 years of age and under are free. All other guests will be charged the above guest fees.

LMCC Members that are not members of the Pool are entitled to visit and enjoy the pool up to two times during the pool season on permitted days. There will be certain black out days throughout the season, and they can be found on the pool calendar. LMCC Members will need to have their current membership card available and cannot bring guests. A visit is defined as at least one member of the household or the full complement of the household attending. LMCC members will sign in and produce their account number through a membership card.

Any class of membership may register a full-time caregiver for a season fee of \$100.00. This fee would allow the caregiver to accompany the identified members at the Pool. The caregiver would not be permitted to use the facilities without the members and cannot bring guests.

A single or couple membership may upgrade to a family membership to include a long-term visit by a relative (i.e. Grandchild, stepchild). The related family member would have the same privilege as a long-term guest and must be accompanied by the pool member. This would be in lieu of the normal guest fee.

No more than four (4) guests per membership will be permitted without prior notice and authorization from club management. In the event of extreme crowding, the general manager shall have the right to limit or deny guest privileges. Any requests to deviate from these rules must be approved by the General Manager or Pool Committee. Private parties may be arranged through the general manager.

General

1. Except for baby food, formula or similar products, food is not permitted within 5 feet of the pool.
2. Members are permitted to bring basket or picnic lunches to the pool. No food is to be stored in the pool refrigerator. Members with infant children are permitted to bring infant formula or other infant food to the pool area. All such provisions shall be stored neatly and disposed of properly in the receptacles provided for that purpose. Glass is prohibited in all forms.
3. No alcohol is permitted.
4. All persons, including members, their families and their guests use the pool facilities at their own risk.
5. LMCC is not responsible for personal injury, loss or damage to personal property.
6. Accidents, no matter how minor, must be reported to either the Pool Manager or lifeguards immediately. An accident report must be filed with the General Manager.
7. Members and guests at the pool should conduct their activities in a manner that permits a safe and enjoyable environment that can be shared by everyone.
8. Club Management, the Pool Committee and the Board of Trustees, at their discretion, reserve the right to expand or limit the number of guests that members can invite to ensure adequate facilities are available for member use.
9. Cabanas will be available for reservation on a daily basis only. (operational details to follow).
10. Chairs and tables may not be reserved.

POOL HEALTH AND SAFETY REGULATIONS

NOTICE: In all matters pertaining to conduct and safety, the decision of the lifeguard in charge is final. The lifeguard will ban anyone who acts in a manner hazardous to themselves and others from the pool area.

1. Wearing of swim caps is optional, but it is recommended that bathers with long hair wear a headband to reduce the possibility of their hair obstructing vision or damaging pool apparatus.
2. No glass containers are allowed in pool area.
3. No running on the pool deck.
4. No smoking or vaping on either the pool deck or designated dining areas. The entire Pool facility is smoke free and vaping free.
5. No rafts or floats are permitted in the pool, however “noodles” and “swimmies” are permitted.
6. Running, pushing, wrestling and activities causing an un-due disturbance in or around the pool area are prohibited.
7. Lifeguards may institute a 15 minute per hour adult swim on active days. There will be dedicated lanes for lap swimming during normal operating hours.
8. The Club reserves the right to deny admission to the pool or pool area to those wearing bandages, having skin abrasions, infection, inflamed eyes or other physical malady that might impose a health risk to other members or guests. The decision of the lifeguard, pool manager or General Manager regarding admission under these circumstances shall be final.
9. Admission will be refused to anyone not in proper bathing attire (swimsuits).
10. Expectorating, nose blowing or other acts likely to contaminate the water, is prohibited.
11. Children not toilet-trained may not use the main pool. They must wear swim diapers and use the baby pool.
12. No one shall use the pool without a lifeguard on duty.
13. Children using the baby pool must always be attended by a parent, registered caregiver or grandparent.
14. Lightning policy – same as beach rule – 30 minute waiting period. Members must leave the immediate pool area.
15. Consistent with health code requirements, all persons who need to wear diapers or other incontinent clothing will be required to wear waterproof attire prior to entering the pool.

NOTE: All individuals using the pool are required to follow all posted Rules and Regulations, as well as the House Rules of the Club.
